Registration Fee JK through 8TH Grade (Per Child) Non-refundable - \$350.00

❖ **Payment Options:**

1. Pay entire registration fee at the time of registration.
2. Include registration fee in the monthly tuition payment. (Half of the registration fee **per child must be paid at the time of registration**).
 - Families choosing to spread the remainder of the registration fee over the course of the year are responsible for the remaining balance if they choose to leave the school or are asked to leave for any reason.
 - Families enrolling after June 9, 2017 will be required to pay the full registration fee at the time registration.

8th Grade Graduation Fee- \$310.00

- ❖ Must be paid on or before June 2, 2017.

Pledge Obligation- Each family is assessed a pledge obligation of **\$350.00**. The pledge is directly applied to the operational costs of SMMS and helps keep our tuition as affordable as possible.

- Pledge amount is automatically deducted on **October 1st** unless paid in full prior to October 1st.
- Families enrolling a child after October 1st, will be required to pay the full pledge amount at the time of registration.

Bishop Raffle Ticket Obligation- Each family is responsible to buy or sell **TEN** raffle tickets. (Tickets are \$10 each) Ticket stubs and money are due on or before November 15, 2017.

- Families will have the \$100 deducted automatically if ticket stubs and money are not submitted by the designated date.
- Families enrolling a child after November 15, 2017 will be assessed a \$100 fee that must be paid at the time of registration.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM (PIP) – Defined as active parent participation of **ALL FAMILIES** in our school by volunteering a minimum 30 hours per year. For single parent families, a minimum 15 hours per year is required. One volunteer hour equals one (1) Parent Involvement Program (PIP) point. This program is a part of each family’s financial agreement with the school. If a family’s hours are not completed within the PIP year, or the fee is not paid, the child(ren) will not be registered for the next school year. Unearned PIP points for 8th grade will result in your child not participating in graduation activities. **5 PIP points must be earned working the Annual Parish Festival.** PIP hours are earned from March 1st through February 28th.

- **Fifteen (15) additional PIP points will be added for not working the five mandatory hours of Festival.**
- **For every hour not completed, the cost will be \$100.00 per point.**
- **Single parent is defined as a parent who has sole custody of their child(ren).**
